As of this date, March 28, 2014, the following amendments are made to the Brown County Municipal Court Bond Schedule:

A Defendant who has a pending misdemeanor or felony case in either the Brown County Municipal Court or Brown County Common Pleas Court shall have their bonds set by the Municipal Court Judge or Magistrate. Any ambiguities of whether or not a Defendant has a pending case in the Brown County Municipal Court or Brown County Common Pleas Court, shall be decided in favor of the Defendant. A pending minor misdemeanor charge shall not be considered as a pending charge.

The amendment to the bond schedule is due to the increasing pattern of defendants posting a bond under the misdemeanor bond schedule that do not reflect an appropriate amount under the factors enumerated under 2937.23 of the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Criminal Rule 46.

MUNICIPAL COURT BOND SCHEDULE SUMMARY (as of March 28, 2014):


All Felonies are to be set solely by the Court.

All Domestic Violence charges are to be set solely by the Court.


All Violation of a Temporary or Permanent Criminal/Civil Protection Orders are to be set solely by the Court.
