

AMENDED TEMPORARY ORDER IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS

Change of procedures for Brown County Municipal Court estimated time

3-24-2020 to 5-18-2020. These dates may change as per the Governor's orders, Ohio

Supreme Court recommendations, etc.

- 1. All civil and criminal pretrials shall be conducted by phone.
- 2. All civil case trials will be set out 60 days, including evictions.
- Only attorneys, parties and witnesses will be allowed in the waiting area of the courthouse.
- All criminal jury trials will be moved and/or set after 5-19-2020 unless the Court
 orders a quicker date due to Defendant being in jail etc.
- Only cash will be received by the clerk at 770 Mt. Orab Pike regarding fines and costs. If one is paying by credit card, this shall be accomplished online or by phone with the clerks.
- 6. All probationers shall report to the Probation Dept. once a month by phone.
- All review hearings concerning probation shall be conducted by phone with the probationer's Probation Officer.
- Temporarily stay the filing and enforcing of any garnishment actions or orders.
- Any court filings except protection orders shall be filed between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. with the clerks
